

If you have ongoing (or "long-haul") medical issues due to work-related COVID-19, you may be eligible for free lifetime medical care through workers' compensation insurance. If your illness causes you to miss work, you may also be eligible for lost wage replacement.

Get benefits through your existing claim or file if you don't have one

If you already have an established workers' compensation claim for COVID-19, any lost wage benefits or ongoing medical care directly or consequently related to COVID-19 falls under that claim. If you do not have an established claim, you need to file a claim within two years of your illness.

Visit http://wcb.ny.gov/covid-19 for the fastest filing. Select "File a Claim," and complete the web version of the Employee Claim Form (Form C-3), or you can complete and submit a paper form.

While not all claims will be accepted, there is no harm or risk in filing a claim, even if it ends up getting denied.
