- This new Population Restriction will verify that the Award/Order Date is not more than 35 days in the future.
 - As we previously did not allow the date that far in the future, this is more of a relaxed edit for Trading Partners. As the Board issues proposed awards that do not become final for 30 days, we are allowing the Award/Order Date to be listed as a future date as some payers, who agree with the decision, pay the award right away vs. waiting for the decision to become final.

NYS R3.1 DN Reporting Specifics document posted at <u>NY Requirement Tables - EDI R3.1</u> states:

DN0036 (Part of Body Injured Code) listed on the FROI is the accepted body part(s) of the claim once acceptance has been designated.

 The Board's Claims Operations unit has found additional parts of body in the DN0038 (Accident/Injury Description Narrative) field, but they are not listed in DN0036 (Part of Body Injured Code). Please remember to list all accepted parts of body in DN0036 (Part of Body Injured Code). If they are not listed in DN0036 (Part of Body Injured Code) and there is supporting medical in the Board file, the body part will be established as part of the ANCR (Accident, Notice, and Causal Relationship) process.

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New Report for Rejected Transactions

- This report will list cases in which a rejected transaction never had any transaction accepted after that rejection. This will assist Trading Partners with clean-up projects to ensure that appropriate transactions have been filed.

Most Frequent Errors Returned During the Past 90 Days



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Population Restriction 0085-064A

This most common error for the last 90 days as well as the top error for 2022 was a carryover edit from eClaims R3.0. The population restriction is intended to prevent a new DN0085 (Benefit Type Code) from being introduced as a sweep benefit if not previously submitted as an Event Benefit or a SROI-UR(G)/SA included the Benefit Type Code. This is based on the IAIABC Claims EDI Section 4 rules. FTP filers should ensure that their systems are programmed accordingly to avoid further rejections.

The second most common error returned in the past 90 days is also an eClaims R3.0 carryover to ensure that DN0075 (Agreement to Compensate Code) is sent as "With Liability" after the Board has issued a Notice that the case has been established with an ANCR/ODNCR finding in accordance with § 21-a. FTP filers should ensure that their systems are programmed accordingly to avoid further rejections.

The third most common error returned in the past 90 days is another eClaims R3.0 carryover. This edit supports the IAIABC Claims EDI Section 4 rules that do not allow BTC 0xx to be introduced on the SROI-SA as a prior Event should have been reported. FTP filers should ensure that their systems are programmed accordingly to avoid further rejections.
