§21-a AMENDMENT

21-a AMENDMENT

- New legislation signed as part of the FY 2026 Budget amends § 21-a of the Workers' Compensation Law to permit workers' compensation insurers to pay for medical treatment, without accepting liability, for up to one year, beginning January 1, 2027.
- The amendment requires insurers to notify injured workers that such payments are being made and that their claim will automatically be accepted by the insurer at the one-year mark, unless the claim is controverted.
- The Board published table changes on 1/9/2026. Payers should review the eClaims Trading Partner table changes posted on the Board's eClaims webpage and update their systems accordingly.

- Given the scope of the changes, we will allow for a period where trading partners can test prior to the 1/1/2027 implementation.

Maintaining Denials on Acquired Claims

AQ- Acquiring Denied Claims

- Severity ranking for DN0075 Agreement to Compensate Code changed from MC to AR. Change Log items #437-438.
- When a payer is acquiring a claim and wishes to maintain a denial already in effect, the payer should file the FROI-AQ with DN0074 Claim Type Code and DN0075 Agreement to Compensate null (blank).

DN0075 (Agreement to Compensate Code)	Changed the severity ranking for DN0075 (Agreement to Compensate Code) on AQ from MC to AR. Business Need: Based on feedback, claim administrator can file an AQ without accepting the claim if they wish to maintain the denial.	1/9/2026	1/1/2027
DN0075 (Agreement to Compensate Code)	Removed AQ from the FROI conditional requirement on DN0075 Agreement to Compensate Code. Business Need: See Change Log Item 411	1/9/2026	1/1/2027

RELAXED AND MODIFIED POPULATION RESTRICTIONS PUBLISHED 01/9/2026 TO BE IMPLEMENTED ON 1/1/2027

- Numerous population restrictions were modified and published on the eClaims change log to be implemented on 1/1/2027.
- These changes align with the Amendments to Workers' Compensation Law Section 21-a Effective January 1, 2027.
- Payers should review the eClaims change log, items 414-416, 422-424, 427-431, 434-44 and 447-450 posted on the Board's eClaims webpage and update their systems accordingly.

Change Log Item 425 and 426 – DN0068-064F

Removed old population restriction DN0068-064F and replaced with new population restriction DN0068-064F.

CHANGE LOG ITEM 423- NEW EDITS AND POPULATION RESTRICTIONS PUBLISHED ON 1/9/2026 TO BE IMPLEMENTED ON 1/1/2027

Several new edits and population restrictions were published on the eClaims change log on 1/9/2026 to align with the Amendments to Workers' Compensation Law Section 21-a effective January 1, 2027.

This edit is effective 1/1/2027 and applies to dates of accidents on or after 1/1/2027.</p> <p>Exception: Effective 1/1/2027 this edit will not be applied if DN0059 (Manual Classification Code) has been accepted as 7711 or 7370.</p> <p>Business Need: To align with 21a for medical effective 1/1/2027.</p>	1/9/2026	1/1/2027
446	Edit Matrix-Population Restrictions	DN0075 (Agreement to Compensate Code)	<p>Added a New Population Restriction DN0075-064 M)</p> <p>M) If DN0075 (Agreement to compensate code) is present and latest value of DN0074 (Claim Type Code) is N (Notification only)</p> <p>Then DN0074 (claim type code) must be included in the change variable segment with a value other then N (notification only). Business Need: To align with 21a for medical effective 1/1/2027.</p>	1/9/2026	1/1/2027
