Subject: Office of General Counsel Report for May 2026 Board Meeting

Below is a statistical analysis for April 2026 of the workflow of the three divisions of the Office of Issue Resolution, within the Office of General Counsel, responsible for deciding cases. This report summarizes the number of hearings held in the Adjudication Division, the number of reviews handled by the Administrative Review Division, and the number of applications for Full Board Review processed by the Legal Affairs Division.

ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW DIVISION

ARD Applications Received:	899 (Attachment D)
ARD Applications Processed:	1,074
ARD Applications Pending:	7,413

Note: In April, ARD processed more cases than it received. The inventory decreased from 7,589 to 7,413 cases. As of May 1, 2026, 57% of review applications were processed within six months of the application date (Attachment E). The most common issue presented for review in April was Rates/Awards (227 cases). See Attachment F for a summary of review outcomes by primary issue.
